## Directions to Mid-Island Y-JCC

### Northern State Parkway

Exit 37, Manetto Hill Road. From the West, make right turn from the exit ramp; From the East, make a left turn. Go south past 5 traffic lights. The Y entrance is on the left, 100 feet after the fifth light.

### Long Island Expressway

From the West, take Exit 45, Manetto Hill Road. Turn left and continue past 5 lights as above. From the East, take Exit 46S (Sunnyside Blvd.) Go south on Sunnyside Blvd. to second traffic light. Turn left onto Manetto Hill Road and continue past 3 traffic lights. The Y is on the left, 100 feet after the third light.

### Seaford Oyster Bay (Route 135)

Exit 10, Old Country Road east to Manetto Hill road (4 traffic lights). Turn left onto Manetto Hill Road. The Y is 1/2 blocks north on the right.

- ✓ Computer and Internet

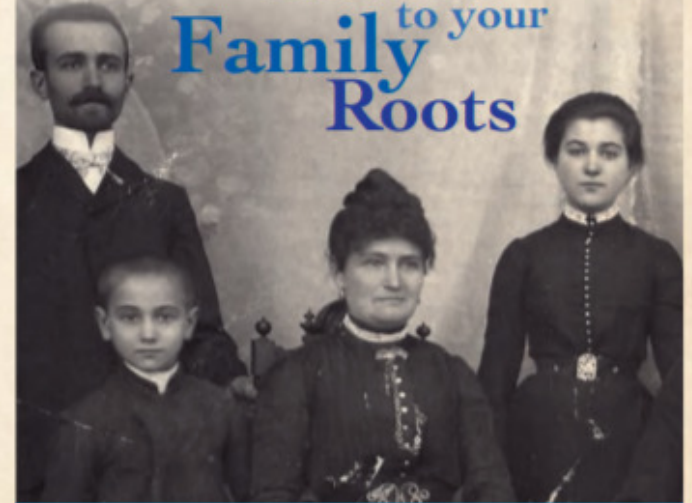
